## Conferences

In 2022 and 2023 LIASCD held two major conferences.

The Fall Conference was held on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 at the Melville Marriot Hotel. It was hybrid event including 215 participants both virtually and in-person. The title was: *Upgrade Your Teaching: Understanding by Design Meets Neuroscience*. The presentation featured co-authors Jay McTighe and Judith Willis. The presentation was based on their book which was the title of the conference. Feed back on the conference was very positive with reflections on questioning and rigor.

The Spring Conference was held in person at the Melville Marriott on March 4, 2022. The title was *Charting a New Course: Next Generation and Innovation*. The format of the day was a morning “Fireside Chat” with Chancellor Lester Young Jr. and NYSED Commissioner Dr. Rosa. They were introduced by Regent Tilles and the “chat” was led by Dr. Lorna Lewis. Following a brief session with our 8 vendors (Houghton, Mifflin Harcourt, Imagine Learning, Max Cases, McGraw Hill Achieve3000, I Tutor, I-Ready Curriculum Associates, Lexmark, Lightspeed), the attendees had the opportunity to be part of one of six presentations in the morning session. After lunch, there were two breakout sessions with six presentations running concurrently. There was a total 18 presentations with 43 presenters representing 14 school districts, Molloy College and BOCES. There were 314 registered.

In 2021 -2022 LIASCD held two networking social events.

The Fall Networking event was held at the Heritage Club at the Bethpage Golf course on November 18, 2021. The title was: *Creating a Sense of Belonging for All Students*. There were Presentations on Attendance from Huntington Schools, Cultural Aspects from Malverne Schools, ELL from Hewlett-Woodmere Schools and Special Education from AHRC. There were 90 people registered.

The Spring Networking event was held at the Heritage Club at the Bethpage Golf course on May 5, 2022. The title was: *Conversation and Collaboration on Cinco de Mayo*. There were 76 people registered. Timely topics were discussed in small groups and shared with the total group.
